Proposals will be accepted until **Thursday, June 25th at 10am** at which time they will be publicly opened and read at the Kearsley School Administration Building. The Board will not accept a proposal received after the date and time mentioned above. The Board of Education reserves the right to accept or reject any and all proposals and alternates, in whole or in part, and to waive any informality therein. **The winning bid will be taken for approval at the Kearsley Board of Education meeting on Monday, June 29, 2026.** Proposals shall remain firm for a period of 60 days from the bid opening.

A. SCOPE OF WORK: The Scope of this request includes: See below.

Location #1: Kearsley High School Auditorium Entrance, 4396 Underhill Drive, Flint, MI 48506

- Tear out approximately 7400 square feet of existing concrete, remove and haul off-site
- Add stone base where needed
- Pour back approximately 5200 square feet of new sidewalk with 4000psi with mesh. Use up to 4" of 21aa limestone for new base fill. Mix with midrange water reducer. Finish slab with broom finish.
- Seal slab for improved strength with 30% cure
- Remove island landscaping and tree
- Topsoil, seed and straw as needed

Work must be completed by Friday, August 7th.
