“Football Concession Vendor Services” RFP

Answers to Questions

1. Question: Are there gas hook-ups at any of the locations? If not, are we allowed to use propane?

Response: The district does not have gas hook-ups available at the locations. Propane use is permitted.

2. Question: Is there ample electricity or the ability to add power, for additional equipment?

Response: We believe there is ample electrical capacity for additional equipment.

3. Question: Can we get a bit more clarification on the game schedules. For example, on 9/18, Plymouth vs Canton shows on both schedules; while on 9/10, Plymouth vs Salem only shows on the Plymouth HS schedule.

Response: The football schedules only include home games for each school.

4. Question: Who chooses the food trucks for the times that are indicated to be special events?

Response: Food trucks for designated special events are selected by the Assistant Principals of Athletics and Activities.

5. Question: Can you provide gross sales for the last five years, per location?

Response: It is the district’s understanding that the private catering company had gross sales of \$25,000 for the fall 2024 season & \$29,000 for the fall 2025 season. No other sales information has been made available to the district.

6. Question: Why is PCCS seeking a new partner to run the concessions?

Response: The district has had complaints regarding the quality of food and menu offerings.

7. Question: Who has run it in the past? Was the school lunch service preparing food for concessions? Did the booster club or volunteers staff the concessions?

Response: Kevin's Catering, a private catering company has run it in the past. No other internal or external entity has been involved.

8. Question: Are there any relationships or sponsors that should or must be included? Ex: Pepsi, pizza vendors etc.

Response: As stated in the RFP, the district currently has a contract with Pepsi.

9. Question: Is it possible to extend the concession service to other sports on the PCCS campus?

Response: Not at this time.
