Utica Community Schools is seeking proposals for the provision of Science Materials Grades 9-12 (B-2447-26).

Interested bidders will need to register through Bonfire at the portal to access the bid documents. Bids must be submitted online to the portal no later than **9:30 a.m., August 5, 2026 (the "Due Date")**. **Submissions through the portal will be the only accepted method to submit proposals for this project.** Proposals will be electronically sealed until the stated Due Date and Time after which they will be publicly unsealed and read aloud via video conference.

All Contractors submitting Proposals must provide a sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the owner or key employee of the Bidder submitting a Proposal and any member of the Utica Community School District Board of Education or the Utica Community School District Superintendent. The District will not accept a Proposal that does not include this sworn and notarized disclosure statement.

All Contractors submitting Proposals must provide a sworn and notarized Affidavit of Compliance pursuant to the Iran Economic Sanctions Act, Michigan Public Act No.517 of 2012. The District will not accept a Proposal that does not include this sworn and notarized disclosure statement.

The School District reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion (for this provision and all other provisions contained in this RFP), to accept or reject, in whole or in part, any or all Proposals with or without cause.
