Federal Procurement Requirements

*School District will take all necessary affirmative steps to ensure that minority firms, women’s business enterprises, and labor surplus area firms are used when possible.

*The vendor must certify that neither the company nor its principals are suspended or debarred from participation in federally funded programs and must comply with all applicable provisions related to suspension and debarment.

*The vendor shall also comply with the requirements of the Clean Air Act and the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, as applicable.

*All food products provided under this contract shall comply with the USDA Buy American Provision. Warren Consolidated Schools participates in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and School Breakfast Program (SBP) and is required to use the nonprofit food service funds, to the maximum extent practicable, to buy domestic commodities or products for Program meals. A ‘domestic commodity or product’ is defined as one that is either produced in the U.S. or is processed in the U.S. substantially using agricultural commodities that are produced in the U.S. as provided in 7 CFR 210.21(d). Vendors shall supply, to the maximum extent practicable, domestic agricultural commodities or products processed in the United States and shall maintain documentation sufficient to demonstrate compliance with this requirement when requested by the School Food Authority.

*Per USDA SP 22-2024, CACFP 08-2024, and SFSP 13-2024, the use of statutorily or administratively imposed in-state or local geographic preferences for procurements under USDA entitlement programs is prohibited, except for unprocessed locally grown or locally raised agricultural products. When geographic preference is used, ABC School District must still get quotes from several suppliers when procuring unprocessed locally grown or locally raised agricultural products so that competitors have an opportunity to compete for the bid.

*All prime construction contracts of more than \$2,000 awarded by non-Federal entities must include a provision for compliance with the Davis-Bacon Act (40 U.S.C. 3141-3144, and 3146-3148) as supplemented by Department of Labor regulations (29 CFR Part 5, “Labor Standards Provisions Applicable to Contracts Covering Federally Financed and Assisted Construction”). In accordance with the statute, contractors must be required to pay wages to laborers and mechanics at a rate not less than the prevailing wages specified in a wage determination made by the Secretary of Labor.

*Any bidder, person, or entity may file a bid protest with Warren Consolidated Schools. The protest shall specify the reasons and facts upon which the protest is based and shall be filed, in writing to the school district no later than three business days after the date of the Bid award or notice of unsuccessful bid. WCS will investigate the basis for the Bid protest and analyze all facts. WCS will notify the Bidder whose Bid is the subject of the Bid protest of evidence found as a result of the investigation and allow the Bidder to rebut such evidence and permit the Bidder to present any evidence that the bid and/or contract award was done in an unfair or biased manner. WCS will issue a written decision within 15 business days following receipt of the Bid protest unless factors beyond the school district’s reasonable control prevent such a resolution, in which event such decision will be issued as expeditiously as circumstances reasonably permit. The decision will state the reasons for the action taken by WCS. A copy of this decision will be furnished to the protestor and any other parties affected.
